The Anglican 1662 version revised.

Revised per Jesus Christ 2016. To indicate its original meaning.

Our Father and Mother, who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy name— I AM THAT I AM.
Thy kingdom come;
thy will of holy be done,
on earth as in heaven in the ascension.
Give us this day our daily grain.
And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those we have a rebirth debt.
And stay us going into temptation
but deliver us to seeing Truth and Evil.
For thou art the kingdom,
the power, and the glory,
Forever and ever.
Amen.

JESUS CHRIST: The original meaning of God is I AM THAT I AM—as given to Moses in the burning bush, as YHVH. You are to use this original meaning shown to you in the Bible, and not be repeating the false concept of the “One (almighty) ubiquitous God” that is omniscient and omnipresent and that is all pervasive such that you do not need to make an effort.¹

(17 sec.) Give us this day our daily grain. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those we have a rebirth debt. And stay us going into temptation but deliver us to seeing Truth and Evil. For thou art the kingdom, the power, and the glory, Forever and ever.
:32 to :40 :45	Our Father and Mother, who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name— I AM THAT I AM. Thy kingdom come; Thy will of holy be >done! Thy will of holy be >done! Thy will of holy be >done! Be <i>done</i> . Be <i>done</i> . (Next is bugle sound)
:45 to	Hallowed be thy name— I AM THAT I AM. (4x) <i>I AM THAT I AM</i> (6x)

Note: Amen in heaven means that you are done speaking. So in the chant, the amen is said only at the end.
