JARVIS RAYMOND: The news reporter acts as sheriff. He follows common sense or natural law.

Immigrant Workers Plan Strike Thursday

Immigrants in D.C. and across the country plan to participate in the “Day Without Immigrants” boycott, a response to President Trump’s pledges to crack down on those in the country illegally, use “extreme vetting” and build a wall along the Mexican border. The social-media-organized protest aims to show the president the effect immigrants have in the country on a daily basis.

JARVIS RAYMOND: Hear the anger.

The boycott calls for immigrants not to attend work, open their businesses, spend money or even send their children to school. The Washington region had the seventh-largest

immigrant population in the country in 2010, with 21.8 percent of the population being foreign-born, according to a study from the Brookings Institution.



JARVIS RAYMOND: Common law does not go by precedent. That is not possible with events of news to be reporting. Neither would the newspaper reporters go by precedent. However it is not as you see in the article by *Washington Post* where you do not have the law stated.

What Is A Common Law Reporting?

ARCHANGEL RAPHAEL: "You will have to back down to us!"

Nancy of Oregon: If they "*plan* a strike". It is striking at you.

NATHAN the Judge: "We are planning to do something about our anger. Show you up."

ARCHANGEL RAPHAEL: "Back down, and we might even destroy property. We can make it unsightly for *you*."

JARVIS RAYMOND: **This would have been the common law way to report this as a newspaper reporter.**

JARVIS RAYMOND: The newspaper reporter was and still is the work of “sheriff” under common law to be a staunch reporter of law and order.

MOSES: It will not be *insurrection* reporting. Far be it from the newspaper reporter to support the illegal immigrants and not the United States.

What is the image here? *Helplessness*. It is clearly illegal, that *the powers that be* are to NAFTA and the illegal immigrants.
