As Grand Master, Fontanes was not a functionary of the Minister of the Interior, but had extensive independent powers. He made all appointments and promotions, granted all diplomas, proposed regulations on teaching, administration, and discipline, and rendered a financial accounting.

NOSTREDAME: The Grand Master Marquis Fontanes would determine whether a teacher or graduate of the University deserved to be granted a diploma.

Marquis Fontanes: It was not a fulfillment of courses only. They had to have passed the grade so to speak in moral character, otherwise they did not receive a diploma. And thus one who did not fit into the curriculum, I told them earlier on, that they either quit now or not receive a diploma.

NOSTREDAME: It was an environment controlled. There was an accountability for a standard. These were students who had graduated from the university to pass the grade of having a personal moral standard.

ANDREA SELESTOW: It is as if he stood at the hall of records to read the tapestry called Life *to you*. Call it the "recording angel records", what have you, however you label this place of wisdom as where Jesus Christ teaches you.

NOSTREDAME: Thus there is the necessity to learn the coordinates found in the book of *Revelation*. That you have the vocabulary, the history and the archetypes to wend your way through life.

Nancy of Oregon: The four horsemen were described in the Book of *Revelation*. They are a foretelling of the world wars. It is a foretelling of plague and famine. And it would be either narcissistic or Pollyanna not to know that this does exist.

ANDREA SELESTOW: Normally you think of the economy of wants and the consumers buying with the money from wages. There is much talk about the stability of an economy based on fair wages. Yet how are the real "needs", the consumer wants, to be determined? Thus it was also the

teachings of Moses in the Old Testament that there are seven years of plenty and seven years of plague.

Does this not make common sense that these cycles are learned as the teachings of Moses as he had been around in Pharaoh's time, to know that you prepare wheat and grains for 7 years that you go through these cycles?

The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse



The white, red, black and death rides a pale horse, are described in the last book of the New Testament of the Bible, called the Book of Revelation of Jesus Christ to John of Patmos, at 6:1-8. The book or scroll in God's right hand that is sealed with seven seals. The Lamb of God opens the first four of the seven seals, which summons four beings that ride out on white, red, black, and pale horses. The four riders are often seen as symbolizing Conquest or Pestilence, War, Famine, and Death.

JESUS CHRIST: These are teachings of the Second Advent. *To prepare grain for seven years. And there is a harvesting at the times of abundance when there follows the night that is after the day.*
