### Biography

Otto Adolf Eichmann was a German Nazi SS-Ober. and one of the major organizers of the Holocaust. Eichmann was tasked by SS-Ober. Reinhard Heydrich with facilitating and managing the logistics involved in the mass deportation of Jews to ghettos and extermination camps in German—occupied Eastern Europe during World War II. In 1960, Eichmann was captured in Argentina. Following a widely publicized trial, he was found guilty of war crimes and hanged in 1962.
