



## On Deuteronomy

**MOSHE:** Some of you have requested the Church not read the passages in Deuteronomy that say “sexual relations” as there are children there. You would at this time put in its place “lust”. The problem was not defined back then down to see what you have seen as the “unbridled lust of men”. As seen at the East side of the Jordan River.

**FATHER MALACHI:** At the time of writing Deuteronomy, there was not an understanding of what would happen to the female servants!

There was furthermore no understanding of the captivity into Babylon to create the Babylonian Jews from the extreme behavior of Solomon that made Israel a work house. The Jews became so weakened to the point of easy takeover. Thus especially in the United States, you would substitute the word “sexual relations” where you find it with, “lust for a high”.

**MOTHER MARY:** This is a danger in the United States. That the youth are taught to seek “highs”. And this “lust for a high” is quite dangerous as you see what happened in the Babylonia captivity that the Jews came back with this distorted thinking.

**ISAIAH:** I did not write Isaiah. I was the Messenger to Moses. And therefore I was not able to take a position as Cosmic Christ is what happened at the coronation.
