



Ascended Masters

The species all have a hard outer skin that is hardened calcium carbonate. The muscular system is without a skeleton. The body is divided into segments, modified among different groups, with each segment originally carrying a pair of jointed legs. In some animals some of the legs have evolved into jaws, sucking organs or weapons.

The demon “Arthropod” shows you how to not have a backbone. In the human, these are ones who have excelled in social etiquette. The arthropods have well-developed digestive, circulatory and nervous systems. They do not however speak up for themselves, they are the proverbial “doormat” that others walk over, and they are not able to counter this as they themselves have not a belief system that might do so.

These are not ones to lead others, they look to follow. Thus one often finds that the demon causes one not to but follow after others or leaders.

These species are structured to be in pieces. They are one way to one person and another will be interacted with differently. They can follow others with little ability to see where they are going as they tend to follow another.

The class includes crabs, lobsters, shrimp, crabs, barnacles and crayfish. It includes spider, tick, mite, scorpion, and harvestman. Of the centipedes, they have flattened, segmented bodies. Most centipedes have about 70 legs, one pair per segment. This demon has many ideas but cannot command his life nevertheless.
