**You do not have time to worry about the last project and feel burdened by the errors, you have to see the next project and be ready at the computer to start producing. The supervisor is standing there waiting for you to input—not create, not alter instruction, not change direction, not go do research, not go here and there—but to stay at the computer while he is behind your shoulders saying directly to you, "Start."**
