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The First Day

In the beginning Creation God made heaven and earth. Everything on the earth was without shape or form. **He created in seven days or long cycles however they were created all from the beginning though one day would lapse over another, one day beginning earlier in conception though not manifesting yet.**

He created the etheric or heavenly kingdoms first.

The structure of nature functions as a divine hierarchy of guardian spirits comprised of greater and lesser evolved beings—Lord Gods, Lords, Elohim, Archangels, Gods and Goddesses of galaxies and sun systems. The mighty Elohim are the builders of form at Creation and thereafter. The Archangels and Elohim work together with their divine complements as directors of the elements. Their joint services emanate through the Holy Spirit in the kingdoms of fire, air, water and earth that include the stepping-down of cosmic power, wisdom and love released from Alpha and Omega.

In the physical kingdom, darkness lay over the deep, and Creation God's spirit moved over the waters. Then Creation God said: "Let there be light!" And there was light. And Creation God saw that the light was good. Then he divided the light from the darkness, and it became evening and morning. Creation God had made the first **"day" or in Creation God's time—what is a long time.**

The Second Day

Creation God said: "Let there be a sky between the waters!" And Creation God made the sky to divide the waters that were above from those that were below. And so it was done. And Creation God called the sky the heavens. And evening came, and morning; and the second day passed.

The Third Day

Creation God said: "Let the waters that are under the sky collect into one place, and let dry land appear." And this was done. Creation God called the dry land earth, and the waters that had collected he called seas. And Creation God saw that it was good. Then Creation God said: "Let the earth yield the green grasses and plants that bear seed, and fruit trees that bear fruit." And this was done. And upon the earth grew grass and plants which had seeds, and fruit trees which bore fruit, each containing its own seed. And Creation God saw that it was good. So evening came, and morning, and the third day passed.

The Fourth Day

Creation God created the solar system for earth to revolve around the sun. He said: "Let there be lights in the heavens, to divide the night and the day. They shall be signs to mark out the day and the year. They shall shine in the sky and spread light over the earth." So Creation God made sun, moon and stars to shine on the earth and to rule day and night and divide the light from the darkness. So evening came, and morning, and the fourth day passed. And so it was done.

The Fifth Day

Creation God said: "Let the waters fill with many, many living creatures." **So Creation God created the corals and plants of the seas. And Creation God saw that it was good. He blessed them saying: "Increase and multiply, and fill the seas, and the air, and the land."** So evening came, and morning, and the fifth day passed.

The Sixth Day and the Day of Rest

Then Creation God said: "Let us make man in our own image and likeness." Let him be master over himself. He gave man free will. He made him in the image of Creation God. He is called the Son of God. He created mankind as man and woman in the etheric or in heaven. And he blessed them and said to them: "As he said of the plants on the land and in the sea and all the living creatures that inhabit the earth—Be fruitful and multiply."

So evening came, and morning, and the sixth day passed.

Thus the creation of the heavens and the earth and of all the life that filled them was completed. And Creation God rested on the seventh day. And he blessed that day and set it apart as a holy day because on it he had rested after all his work of creation.

Creation

This passage is the foundation stone of all the doctrine of the Bible. All things in the universe belong to Creation God because he entirely made them. For the same reason, each of them reflects some aspect of his glory and speaks of him to man.

He created the etheric or heavenly kingdoms first. Humans do not see into these realms. They walk a path of faith as they are not able to see and believe in Alpha and Omega, in the Elohim and Archangels as these are the Father Mother God, the builders of form and the guardians of their souls while they journey on the earth.

While older Bibles record that Creation God made all the different animals, and insects, and reptiles to say: "Let the earth bring forth living creatures of all kinds, cattle and creeping things, and wild beasts." The first root races on the earth did not have to take physical

embodiment. The animals and insects were not created by Creation God but by the miscreations of scientific evolutions from afar not from earth, or by man himself who would grow thorns on the rose bushes as his heart was not pure. This happened over many epochs and long cycles.

Man was said to have been created in the first six days of creation before the day of rest. He was created in the physical realms only after the fall of man when man was required to embody on the earth. Before then, man lived in the etheric realms or heavenly kingdom.

To make himself understood by simple people, the Creation God is no ordinary workman: Creation God said, his work is perfect when he said, "He saw that it was good". When all these things were ready, Creation God gave man free will and to enjoy the beauty of his creation and gave him a day of rest to worship.

So it is said: The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof. The law and order of Creation God always prevail. All that goes against cosmic law in time will cease in the final judgment.
