


Calling For The Fishers of Men

Jesus Christ and Apostles Ascended
of Page 208 of *A Bible Story*



In the beginning before the Christ mission, the Light shines not in the hearts of men. There is a man sent from God, whose name is Jesus. He comes for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe. He is sent to bear witness of that Light, which lights every man that comes into the world.

Jesus standing on a shore wonders how he might have those to hear the word of God around him. Now Jesus sees a boat lying on the shore. He climbs into one of the boats of two fishermen, Peter and Andrew. He sits down and speaks of the lineage of the Christ mission and to make a timely decision in the day of the Lord.

Jesus said that this day would be a time of the sun shining when the Christ message would be taught. Its teacher would not be with them forever and to take advantage of the time allowed and this period of time. In the history of man, it would a special time for them.

Jesus conveys to them, it is a day when the Lord shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the Lord will be the hope of his people, and the strength of those who can be a part of the lineage of the Ancient of Days, Sanat Kumara.

So shall ye know that I am come in the name of the Lord Sanat Kumara, the Ancient of Days, your God dwelling in Zion, the holy mountain. Jerusalem shall be holy for a season while these Christ teachings shall come forth. You learn of the Son of God in the son of Man. You learn of the teachings of love that is different from the ways of karma at present of: an eye for an eye. It is a new message of forgiveness. Come be fishers of men with me.

It shall come to pass in your day that the mountains shall drop down as new wine, or new understandings, into new wineskins. Out of the hills shall flow with milk, or these new Christ teachings. And all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters of living fire, or the Holy Spirit. And a fountain shall come forth of the house of the Lord, and also water in the valley.

Thus Jesus teaches these two and gives the vision of the coming teachings of Christ. When he finishes speaking, he says to Peter and Andrew, the fishermen: **"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."**

From there, going on are other fishermen washing their nets. Jesus speaks to James the son of Zebedee and John his brother in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and he calls them.

Jesus gives them teachings as they were without law. And without law, they are not under the law to God or under the law to Christ. They are as weak

without the law of Christ. And these knowing they are weak, seek how they might gain. So run in a race run as these. That you might obtain and receive the prize.

What is their reward then? Verily that, when they would preach the gospel, they may make themselves anew in the gospel of Christ without charge, that they be learners and derive their power from the gospel. And unto the Christ, they become as a Christ that they might gain Christhood under the law.

Though these apostles are free from all men in working for Christ, yet they have made themselves servant unto all that they might gain the more. Though they even be alone to preach the gospel, they do not have to glory of it, for necessity is laid upon them to become the Christ in the teachings of Christ as they go forth to preach it if they would but preach the gospel. Every man that strives for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it not to obtain a corruptible crown but to be as ones incorruptible. For if they did this thing willingly, they have a reward. But against it, they lose a dispensation of the gospel that was not committed to them.

And this, the apostles would do for the gospel's sake, that they might be partaker thereof with Christ Truth.

These fishermen then become new disciples. They leave their boats and follow Jesus. Jesus later would have twelve disciples around him. He called them apostles or messengers. These men accompany him everywhere and proclaim his message.

Jesus chooses twelve simple men to learn from him and to teach others. This is the Church in its earliest infancy. Those who work for our Lord thus learn by doing. So do this Christ mission and change into the Christ. Let us be encouraged, Christ is at our side. And let us pray for the Lord of the harvest to send forth laborers into his harvest." (Matt. 9:38)
