


Jesus Christ Educating on The Christ Mission In the Second Letter of Peter

I am Simon Peter writing a letter as a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, addressing those who have obtained precious like faith through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ as ourselves the 12 apostles and the disciples of Jesus.

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

Our Lord Jesus Christ has revealed this to me, that the tent of my body will soon be folded up. For this reason I am making sure by writing this letter that even after I am gone, you will still remember to hold fast to your calling as chosen ones of God. You who are the keepers of the flame must know that you came with Sanat Kumara to keep the Christ flame and this will continue even after the mission of Jesus Christ and even when you ascend into heaven.

We the apostles proclaim to you that Christ will come again, we were eyewitnesses of his glory. On the holy mountain of Tabor, we heard the voice of Alpha and Omega and many Fathers and Mothers in heaven saying: "Thou art my beloved Son, having embodied the Son of God in man, in whom I am well pleased."

Beloved ones, remember this: with the Lord, one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like one day. The Lord does not delay with his promise, though many think that he does. No, it is for your sakes that he has long suffering toward us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

The day of the Lord will come as unexpectedly as a thief. Then the heavens will vanish in a whirlwind, the elements will be scorched up and dissolve with heat, and the earth and all that is in it will be burned with fire.

There will be the Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto Jesus, to show unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass. And Jesus sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John, saying:

They will hear the words of the prophecy of Jesus Christ, and keep those things which are written therein until the time is at hand.

A door is opened in heaven: and the first voice heard is as it were of a trumpet talking; which said, Come up hither, and I will show thee things.

And immediately in the spirit; you as John the revelator will see a throne set in heaven, and one sits on the throne.

And he that sits is to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

And round about the throne are four and twenty seats: and upon the seats of four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they have on their heads crowns of gold.

And out of the throne, proceeds lightning and thundering and voices: and there are seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

And before the throne, there is a sea of glass like unto crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, are four beasts full of eyes before and behind.

And the first beast is like a lion. And the second beast like a calf. And the third beast has a face as a man. And the fourth beast is like a flying eagle.

And the four beasts have each of them six wings about him; and they are full of eyes within. And they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

And when those beasts give glory and honor and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever, the four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

Thou art worthy O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Thus the mission of Christ will continue until the day of the Lord Sanat Kumara as the emerald to return to bind the tares sown among the wheat and in that day there will be the mission of Christ spread again after the first mission throughout the lands.

Beloved ones, live in this expectation, and take every care that Gods shall find you blameless. Make the best of his merciful delay in his return with the wisdom God has given you. Take warning, then, in time, and do not let yourselves be carried away by the wickedness of the godless. Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever. Amen.

Peter's farewell is "hold fast to your calling." The vision is for the apostles and disciples to have longsuffering.

This vision of the Christ mission should goad us always in the mission. "All the king's servants, and the people of the king's provinces, do know, that whosoever, whether man or woman, shall come unto the king into the inner court, who is not called, there is one law of his to put him to death, except such to whom the king shall hold out the golden scepter that he may live: but I have not been called to come in unto the king these many days." (Esther 4:11)

Though Israel be carried away into Babylon from Jerusalem with the captivity and though Isreal is destroyed by the Suern Persecution Priests, we are to have longsuffering, that the mission of Jesus Christ will return and be manifested in glory.

This teaching of Jesus Christ was given unto Peter who would not ascend for thousands of years as he was unable to maintain the Christ walk as he had pride.
