In the book of *Revelation*, Jesus Christ declares the authority by which he becomes Christ, he declares and repeatedly says unto himself what is the promise in becoming Christ—I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

John the apostle says, "From Jesus Christ, *who is* the faithful witness, *and* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood." What he is teaching is that through the study of the Christ teachings and doing the works of Christ Light, that one would walk a path of the Ruby Cross of sacrifice, surrender, selflessness and service.

We are emissaries of the Most High God to bring about this Light into the kingdom of God in heaven to be on earth. For it is written, "And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen."

John writes further to—Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen—he was referring to the Christ Light, to the Christ teachings.

He says, "I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, for the Word of God through the teachings of Jesus Christ."

John was imbued with the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind him a great voice as of a trumpet of Jesus Christ speaking to him after his ascension when he wrote down the words in the book of *Revelation*:

Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send *it* unto the seven churches which are in the continents.

John turned to see the voice that spoke to him. He turned and he saw seven golden candlesticks. These are the seven lights of the chakras, of the seven Rays, of the seven manifestations of the Rays of God—God power, love, mastery, control, obedience, wisdom, harmony, gratitude, justice, reality, vision, victory.

John himself recalled the teachings of Jesus before the completion of his mission.

Jesus said, **Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:**
But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

For Jesus had asked those in doubt, **Dost thou believe on the Son of God?**
Others who had not belief would answer Jesus, "Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him?"

And Jesus said of the Christ that he came to teach on: **Thou hast both seen him.**

And these who recognized the Christ Light would say: Lord, I believe. And then worship Christ.

For Jesus said, **For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.**
